Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are happy to announce that Camp Mishannock will begin its 2010 summer season on July 4th and will continue through August 14th. Camp is open to girls ages 5-15 years old for both the day and residential programs. As in the past, each Sunday is "Opening Day" at camp from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. This means that all residential campers check in, get assigned their cabin, meet new friends, and have their swim test. Day campers are also encouraged to come in, purchase their T-shirts, and get acquainted on these Sundays during the same time.

This summer we are initiating some changes to the program that will enhance your child's experience at camp. You can see some of the new, exciting things we have planned on our website in the near future!

Campers are asked to register by sessions. With the consistency of a two week camp program the camper will be able to show growth in skills, especially swimming. There will be one optional overnight experience offered each session for day campers at the cost of \$30.00 per child.

Morning drop-off for the day campers begins Monday morning at the tennis courts between 8:30 and 8:45 a.m. and pick up is at 5:30 p.m. Friday includes optional dinner and campfire and pick-up is between 7:30 and 7:45 p.m. at the tennis courts.

Day campers are expected each day to bring with them the following items: blue shorts (no denim), white shirts, sneakers, sunscreen, bathing suit and towel, rainy day gear (as appropriate), sweatshirt, water bottle, and a change of clothes. All articles should be marked with your child's name. Also, a health form signed by a physician is required before the child can come to camp. All campers will be checked by the camp nurse the day they arrive at camp.

Canteen is available twice a week for the children. Canteen is similar to a "general store" where the children are able to choose a snack and beverage. There will be a variety of other items for purchase including water bottles, camp bracelets, and postcards. Campers will also have a "charge card" in the office to keep track of your daughter's spending. Postage stamps will not be provided for mail.

The campers in the Teen Travel Program will also have a "charge card" in the office to keep track of their spending at camp and on trips. Trips are optional and an extra cost, prices will be available the first day of camp.
